## **35<sup>th</sup> Annual Kendall Lions Club Golf Tournament Rules, Regulations and Information**

International welcomes your interest in joining our commitment to drive the goal to end  
Global Sight Impairment and Continue to serve humanity with humble Lion Pride.

1. Each team must designate Captain.
2. Format is 4 man scramble. Each player hits from tee. Captain selects groups best shot. Remaining balls are picked up and played from Captain's choice for second shot. Process is repeated until hole is completed and is played for full 18.
3. Record score as total number of strokes played from Captain's choice spot on card.
4. A completed signed score card is required for Grand prize eligibility and all names in group must be printed on card.
5. All players must shoot off the tee at each hole.
6. Captain's choice shot must be played as it lies and all others must be dropped within 2 foot diameter. Tee may be used to mark Captain's choice lie.
7. All teams must putt out in hole.
8. First Ball in cup is the score required for scorecard.
9. Ties for low score will be settled using best score on course's hole difficulty total tally, starting with most difficult hole. In case of tie Longest Drive, all groups Will tee off and longest drive on fairway will be winner.
10. Hole 10 is Men's Longest Drive. Hole 1 is for women. Team Captain will record name on marker and place.
11. Hole 18 is closest to the pin for men. Hole 6 is closest to the pin for Women.
12. HRGCC rules are in effect for course and will be communicated day of tournament -  
Simple Etiquette:
  - Repair all divots
  - No carts on apron, greens and tee's
  - And Standard Golf Etiquette should be observed at all times
13. When finished, please return cart to designated area. Captains must immediately tally scorecard, sign and turn in to tournament chairperson.
14. The 15<sup>th</sup> Hole will be played with only a 7 iron, putting included.
15. All Par 3 challenges are free to play. Limit 1 stroke per person.
